PARELLI NATURAL HORSE.MAN.SHIP CLINIC  
With 3 Star Instructor Ron Pyne**

Are you looking to establish a deeper partnership with your horse? Levels 2/3 are about confidence and harmony. Now that you understand safety and have the basic skills with equipment and can play the 7 games, it's time to learn how to win those games, and improve your communication. Now, you will begin to have more fun with your horse!

- You will learn to how add purpose to the 7 Games, increase your Online skills and add interest with the use of obstacles and the Parelli Patterns.
- Use of phases: from teaching to reinforcing - Make vs Want - Help your horse get exuberance!
- With Freestyle Riding and the Parelli Patterns, learn how straight lines and circles effect how horses think and how to begin a program to balance their “Whoa and Go.”

This is a four day course with a minimum of two 3-hour teaching sessions each day (24 hours of instruction). Approximately 1/3 of the time will be spent with ground skills and 2/3's on riding skills.

**August 21** is the unofficially start of the clinic, beginning with a fun afternoon of Games, challenges and a trail ride. All participants are invited to take part in the fun. There is no charge for this and spectators are welcome..

**August 22 and 23** will be full clinic days.

**August 24** Private lessons with Ron can be scheduled in the morning. In the afternoon we'll take the horses swimming at the beach, winding up the day with a Lobster/Steak feast!

**August 25 and 26** will be full clinic days.

Prerequisite: All participants should be comfortable walking and trotting their horses in an enclosed area prior to this clinic. You are not required to have attended a Level 1 Clinic but a thorough understanding of the basic concepts and skills of Level 1 and Level 2 are expected. A study/review of the “Success Series” and Parelli Patterns will accelerate your learning experience before this clinic!

Tools Required: Rope Halter, 12 foot line, 22 foot line, Carrot Stick, Savvy String, Parelli Natural Hackamore, saddle, saddlepad.

Cost : \$875 (tax included) per participant (limit of 10 students)

A \$400 deposit must accompany the registration form. Balance due July 1, 2012

Auditing Tickets: \$25 per day or \$40 for 2 days or \$75 for 4 days.

The facility includes an indoor arena, outdoor riding ring, round pen, playground, and trails.

Please do not bring an unstarted horse or a horse that has not been ridden in a long time. If you are not comfortable to do this when it is time to ride, you will be asked to take your horse out and only watch. No refund will be given. Stallions are not permitted. Individual situations vary, so please pass on any special requests to the PNH Event Host for consultation with the instructor.

\_\_\_\_\_ Do not change rider or horses during the PNH Event. If a rider or horse becomes unable to complete the PNH Event, another person should not step in, and likewise, a different horse should not be used for the remainder of the PNH Event. No refund will be given, as the PNH Event Host cannot be responsible for unforeseen problems.
